

## MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

Agreement is made this 12 day of November 1986 by and between the author, Andre Norton, whose address is c/o Richard Curtis, 164 East 64th St., NY, NY 10021, and Susan Shwartz, the Editor, whose address is 1 Station Square #306, Forest Hills, NY 11375.

The Author warrants that the work Dowry of the Ragpicker's Daughter is his/her own and hereby grants to the Editor the right to print it in an anthology tentatively titled MORE ARABIAN NIGHTS, to be published by Avon Books, New York.

It is mutually understood and agreed that the use of this story by the Editor entails First Anthology Rights, both in the English language and in translation anywhere in the world, and in hardcover, paperback, book club, reprint, and Braille editions of the anthology. It is also understood and agreed that the Editor may use this story only in the above anthology and reprintings of it, and that the Author retains all rights not specified here. All royalties and payments accruing to the Editor, less agent's fees, for all editions and reprintings of the volume, are to be distributed among the Editor and the writers as specified in the paragraph below;


For the rights granted to the Editor, the Author will receive the sum of \$350, to be forwarded within 60 days of signing this agreement. This fee represents the Author's full share of advance royalties; and once total royalties earned by the anthology, less agent's fees, equal the total amount paid out to writers, all additional royalties will be divided equally among all writers to 50% of royalties, with Editor receiving the remaining 50%, from which amount the Editor must meet all her expenses other than advances against royalties.


The Editor agrees to provide the Author with one complimentary copy of the anthology's original edition, to do her best to provide copies of editions printed outside the United States, and to inform Author of any editions which are planned or may appear. The Author agrees to keep Editor posted of current address;

If the anthology of stories has not been published within 24 months of signing this contract, the author has the right to sell or arrange for publication of the above-named story in any manner she or he wishes, with the reservation that the Editor will have the nonexclusive right to include the above-mentioned story in an anthology of stories about the Arabian Nights at any time in the future without paying any additional advances, and without prejudice to all the other rights of the Author in this agreement. Author is expected to make no repayment of advances if for any reasons -- publication delays or otherwise -- rights have reverted;

All non-print rights to the above-named story remain the Author's exclusive property.

I have read and understand all of the above and agree to it.
