CONTRACT

Letter of Agreement made this 20th day of July, 1991 between Mary Elizabeth Allen, Proprietor and Editor of the Anthology ALL HALLOWS' EVE, and Andre Norton (Miss)

Proprietor of the Work entitled THE NABOB JEWELS approximately 8,000 (or fewer) words in length.

Proprietor of the Work hereby licenses and grants to Mary Elizabeth Allen, hereinafter known as Editor, the right and permission to include the Work in an anthology entitled ALL HALLOWS' EVE. Proprietor grants non-exclusive world anthology rights in all languages throughout the world. It is expressly understood that the Publisher of this Anthology, Walker and Company, will have the right to license paperback, large print, book club and overseas editions of the Anthology. Proprietor retains all other rights to the Work including the right to grant non-exclusive anthology rights and first and second serial rights on the understanding that the Anthology will be mentioned and credited.

Proprietor warrants that he or she is the sole owner of the rights hereby granted and has full power to enter into this agreement; that the Work is original and is not in the public domain: that it does not violate the right of privacy of any person; that it is not libelous or obscene; that is does not infringe upon the statuary or common-law copyright of anyone; and that any recipe, formula or instruction contained in the Work is not injurious to the user. The Proprietor shall hold harmless the Editor, the Publishers and any and all other publishing firms licensed by the Published to publish the Anthology from any and all disputes and judgments finally sustained arising from ownership of rights herein granted or any other disputes and judgement regarding the Work.

It is understood that it is the responsibly of the Proprietor to give to the Editor at the time the Work is submitted any required copyright notices and credit lines, a brief biographical note and a brief note on the work (which may or may not be used in the published Anthology) and his or her year of birth (required by Walker and Company's managing editors office, but not made public).
