Sknore Norton

The winner of the 1963 Invisible Little Man Award presented by the Elves, Gnomes and Little Men's Science Fiction, Chowder and Marching Society is one of the most popular and noted writers in the field. In our judgment she is one of the two or three greatest story tellers now writing science fiction.

Alice Mary Norton, or Andre Norton, as she prefers to be known, a children's librarian for many years, has been a staunch defender of science fiction and fantasy, witness her article, "Living in 1980 Plus--" in the Library Journal of September 15, 1952. Even more important, as a writer of science fiction she has set a high standard of quality, through her own work, both reader and writer in the field. She writes with fine, perceptive English, with vivid style and swift pace, with sensitive awareness of living entities -- human, animal, intelligent non-human. Her wolverines, dolphins, eagles become as real to the reader as Elsa the lioness, or Mij, Durrell's otter; all of us who have grown from the world of "talking beasts" to an adult, warm, yet unanthropomorphic appreciation of the animal kingdom will find rich delight in Miss Norton's deft exposition of human-animal relationships, along with her understanding of human-human, and her suggested human-alien relations.


